



# Eastern Golf Challenge

Die Provinzen Ontario und Québec sind ein wahres Golfparadies, was leider bei uns in Europa noch nicht so bekannt ist. Nebst Golf hat diese Region auch in Bezug auf Sehenswürdigkeiten und Natur sehr viel zu bieten. Sie werden also nebst dem Golfen mehr als genug Gelegenheit und Zeit haben, um Ostkanada kennenzulernen. Für Sie sind 13 Übernachtungen und insgesamt sieben Tee Times auf den schönsten Golfplätzen vorreserviert, welche sich perfekt in eine Selbstfahrerreise zwischen Toronto und Montréal einbauen lassen. Sie spielen Angus Glen, Battlefield, Ussher's Creek, Deerhurst Highlands, La Bete, Le Diable und Fairmont Chateau Montebello. Nebst dem Golfen besuchen Sie auf dieser Reise die Niagara Fälle, den Algonquin Park, Ottawa sowie Mont Tremblant und lernen selbstverständlich auch die Städte Toronto (inkl. Hafenrundfahrt) und Montréal kennen. Bezüglich Unterkünften besteht die Auswahl zwischen den Kategorien Budget und Comfort.

**Tag 1: Toronto** Pick up your rental car at Toronto airport and make your way downtown Toronto.

**Tag 2: Toronto** Golf at the Angus Glen Golf Club offers beauty, challenge, and first-class service. The fairways on the North Course at Angus Glen are lined with jagged, peaky, fescue-covered dunes, and riddled with three and four foot sod wall bunkers. While the fescue dunes are grown freely to their

natural height of approximately two feet, the sod walls are kept tightly trimmed to reveal the menacing vertical faces complete with the Scottish-style layering of the sod. Included Activity: Toronto Harbour & Island 1 hour Cruise This is the best boat tour to provide you entertaining, insightful, and informative information about everything in town. Enjoy your 1-hour fully narrated Inner Harbour and Island Cruise. Our

professional and friendly crew will be happy to guide you along the way!

**Tag 3: Toronto – Niagara Falls (127 km)** Enjoy a leisurely drive around Lake Ontario, to Niagara Falls. Continue along the shores of the Lake to the historic town of Niagara-on-the-Lake, this region is well known for its' orchards and wine production, home to many cottage wineries. Along the scenic



drive from Niagara on the Lake to Niagara Falls you will pass Peller Estates and Inniskillin. Further along the Niagara Parkway you will pass Queenston Heights Park, The Floral Clock and the Whirlpool Rapids.

**Tag 4-5: Niagara Falls** The Battlefield course boasts a decided links look and a variety of holes that allows golfers to experience the generous rolling fairways and greens, however also offers a mixture of fairways bound by dense forest and brush. With its thick stands of deciduous trees and strong contours, Ussher's Creek looks like a classic parkland course. The mature Carolinian forest along with a sea of bunkers are ready to snare any wayward strokes, and present an intimidating optical illusion.

**Tag 6: Niagara Falls – Huntsville (328 km)** Today you will bypass Toronto and make your way to Huntsville in the Muskoka region of Ontario. Also known to locals as “cottage country” where many families from the city escape to in the summer months.

**Tag 7: Huntsville** The Deerhurst Resort Highlands Course designed by Robert Cupp & Thomas McBroom is a 7,011-yard course and was recently named Best Course in Cottage Country. Bold granite outcroppings and dramatic terrain shifts are optimized at signature hole, #10, where elevated tee areas perch 30' high above a natural rock wall. Dense, mature forests characterize most of the course while holes 4, 5 and 6 break out into an open links-style swirl.

**Tag 8: Huntsville – Ottawa (340 km)** Today you will be traveling east through Algonquin Park towards Ottawa. Enjoy a visit to the Interpretive Centre and Pioneer Logging Exhibit for an audio/visual presentation of the history of the park.

**Tag 9: Ottawa – Mont Tremblant (164 km)** Today you will be heading out to the Laurentian Mountains a majestic presence on the Quebec landscape. In addition to this mighty mountain range and its highest peak, Mont Tremblant, the region is also home to an abundance of immense lakes, wandering rivers, dense forests, rich agricultural plains, and foothills dotted with picturesque villages. Every village offers something unique be it pleasant restaurants, art galleries, antique shops, factory outlet shopping and more.

**Tag 10-11: Mont Tremblant** Le Diable Golf Course is a real treat for photographers. With its imposing red-sand bunkers, its long, narrow fairways and the mountain backdrop, Le Diable is as much surprising in pictures as it is in reality. La Bête is a magnificent championship golf course. Located

along the road into Mont Tremblant, La Bête is quickly gaining a reputation as one of Canada's best courses. Offering everything a discriminating golfer cares about – immaculate grooming, bent grass tees, pristine greens and fairways, and a variety of challenging holes.

**Tag 12: Mont Tremblant – Montebello (90 km)**

You will depart Mont Tremblant in order to golf at Fairmont Chateau Montebello. Chateau Montebello Golf Club winds tightly through graceful forests and features dramatic elevation changes, captivating the imagination of golfers from all over the world. Some of its elevated tees provide lovely views of the gentle rolls of the surrounding Laurentians. Unlike most new layouts today, each hole at Montebello seems secluded, providing that lovely closed-in feeling, like your group is the only one on the course.

**Tag 13: Montebello – Montreal (134 km)** Spend your last day exploring some of the following Montreal highlights: Notre Dame Cathedral, old Montreal with its cobbled streets and outdoor restaurants, and the old port.

**Tag 14: Montreal** Based on your flight times depart for Montreal International airport to drop your vehicle and check in for your flight home.
